Application industries

- **Financial sector**
Optimization of processes, bills-free transaction, foreign currency exchange
- **Media industry**
Shared spaces of content and license information
- **Public sector**
Ledger for land registry, who owns what
- **Legal sector**
New types of contracts, cost reduction for micro payments
- **Medical engineering**
Immutable decentralized documentation of medical records, access to data defined by user-specific roles
